Clerkship Procedure Elective Requirements

- Complete course registration through Qualtrics survey link
- Add/drop form to curriculum office to enroll in the MEDI 5004 self-study elective
- Review all course content
 - Course content is divided into five main areas. Within each of these you will find a combination of slide sets, pdf documents, as well as short videos.
- Write a short reflection essay based on your experience using the prompt below. **Do this before starting the final quiz***
 - "Write to 500-to-1000-word reflection essay on your experiences during the procedure elective. The goal of this elective is to give you more exposure and time to practice some of the foundational procedures that you may be expected to perform as a physician (CBO 2.8). We would also like feedback about your experience in this elective and any suggestion for improvement. The question below is provided as a possible prompt you are not obligated to answer all components of the question.
 - "Based on your experience during this elective what specific opportunities for practice improvement do you want to target during the remainder of your clerkship year and during your enrichment experiences? What content did not seem that relevant to you or could be improved? Are there any bedside procedures that we should add to the curriculum and why?"
- Take Cumulative quiz based on all assigned course content copy and paste your reflection essay at the end of the quiz.
- Perform 5 each of the procedures listed below using sim equipment that is available on each regional campus – record a video of you performing each of these procedures and submit these via the link on the course webpage
 - Peripheral IV
 - o **IO**
 - Bougie assisted Intubation
 - o BVM
 - Donning and Doffing PPE for Contact Precautions
 - o Patient consent for blood transfusion

There is one submission page for all videos, but you are encouraged to be recording videos as you move through the curriculum rather than saving them all and recording at the very end.
