### **NBME Subject Scoring**

Students must achieve at least the 5th percentile on one of two attempts on each of the end-of-clerkship NBME subject examinations to pass the clerkship. If a student does not receive a passing score on either the initial exam or the retake exam, s/he will receive a “D” for the clerkship regardless of the clinical grade. There is no cutoff exam score to achieve any grade above a “D.”

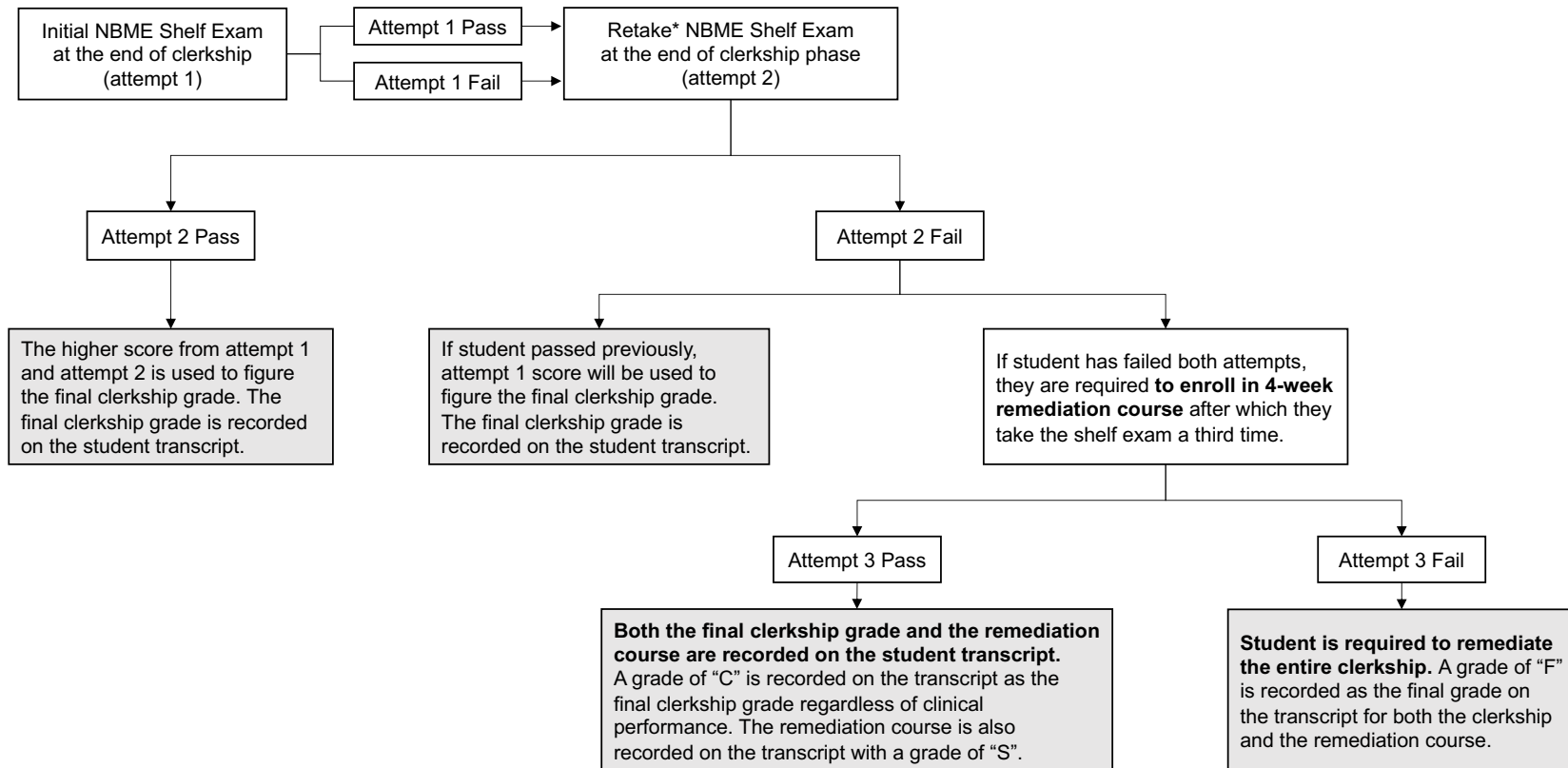
The higher of the two NBME Subject Exam scores will be reported on a student’s MSPE for all core clerkships in addition to their overall score for the clerkship.
