### Application Deadlines

- GACE Program Admissions Assessment\* – required for all MAT concentrations. Exemption options listed below. Registration for the assessment can be found at: [www.gace.ets.org](http://www.gace.ets.org)
- GACE Content Assessment\* – required **ONLY** for Secondary, Art, Foreign Language and Music concentrations. Registration for the assessment can be found at: [www.gace.ets.org](http://www.gace.ets.org)
- Georgia Educator Ethics Assessment (360) – Registration for the assessment can be found at: [www.gace.ets.org](http://www.gace.ets.org)

**GACE Exemption Options** – You may be eligible to exempt the GACE Program Admissions Assessment if:

- SAT – If taken *prior* to July 1, 2019 - scored 1000 or higher (Critical/Evidence-Based Reading & Math)  
If taken *after* July 1, 2019 - scored 1080 or higher (Critical/Evidence-Based Reading & Math)
- ACT – scored 43 or higher (English and Math)
- GRE – scored a 297 or higher (Quantitative and Verbal)

### Additional Information

- For Secondary concentrations – you must have obtained a Bachelor’s degree or have at least successfully completed 21 undergraduate credit hours in upper-level content courses in the content you are pursuing.
- All required documents must be received by the listed documentation deadline per term. Incomplete applications will be withdrawn or can be deferred to the next term one time upon request
