- b. Reese Library Director Update (MJohnson)
 - i. 3rd Floor Shifting
 - 1. Finished two weeks ahead of schedule
 - 2. Now can work on moving last row of shelving for the new furniture
 - ii. Special Collections Librarian
 - 1. Courtney Berge has been selected
 - iii. Information Services Librarian
 - 1. Will be posted by the start of the new fiscal year
 - iv. Donation
 - 1. 1,500 WWII books donated to the library evaluated by TWeeks and MJohnson
 - v. BWarren has created Strategic Planning Committee
 - 1. Review and revise the goals; the meeting will be in July
- c. Dean of Libraries Update (BWarren)
 - i. Will receive update at next Libraries' Faculty Unassembly
- d. Changes to Library Faculty Assembly Bylaws (TWeeks)
 - i. TWeeks shared the bylaws virtually. Electronic vote will be sent out by STharrington.
 - ii. JGaines, TWeeks, STharrington worked on changing the bylaws
 - iii. Change language to "Dean of Libraries" and "Vice Provost for Instructions" and others to reflect title changes
 - iv. Dean of Libraries rights and privileges changed to be non-voting member
 - v. New members of the Assembly is now changed to start in July 1^{st} to reflect the university faculty assembly
 - vi. Biggest change in bylaws chair of the faculty assembly serve as senator or nominate a proxy. In the past we had one or two senators we elected. It should be our chair serves as senator and one additional senator totaling two. Chair can nominate a proxy.
 - vii. The language of the secretary setting up voting was changed.

- viii. The Promotion Review Committee is the new name for the Promotion Portfolio Review Committee as there were changes to the promotion guidelines. Will review library promotion guidelines as needed.
 - ix. Professional Development Committee called Professional Development in Research with a goal to assist faculty. Folded the job duties into one committee.
 - x. If the chair is unable to act as senator they are allowed to select a proxy for one year.
 - xi. This is currently a review and not for a vote.
- xii. JDavis brought up individuals on the director's leadership since they are more than 50%. This rule exists at the university senate level. This is just a suggestion for consistency. TWeeks notes that a lot of faculties will be at administration level soon. NReese feels that they should mirror it to the university ruling. Those of that level would not serve as chairs of those committees, reducing the risk of bias of bias.
- xiii. MJohnson states that they cannot serve on the senate or the committee since they are not voting members, therefore it is fine to them not having a vote.
- xiv. Agreed to have all decisions agreed upon at once to prevent the delay of voting and pushing back the date.
- xv. Many of the issues for committees will determine on the percentage of administration for each individual. Will be reached out to JGaines to determine her specific percentage
- xvi. Draft will be sent out by TWeeks and then voted on by survey sent from STharrington

 - i. New chair is Dr. Tiana Curry-McCoy currently serving as interim chair until next full faculty assembly meeting, where she is official voted in
