Laboratory Services

CLIA-waived laboratory services are performed in the Student Health Clinic and others through a contracted reference laboratory. Once accepted into a program at Augusta University, students are eligible to have titers drawn at Student Health prior to their enrollment date to assist in meeting the AU immunization requirements.

Blood tests are drawn Monday – Friday: 8:00AM - 3:30PM

Laboratory tests ordered by medical providers who are not associated with AU Student Health Services: Students will need to see a medical provider at the Student Health Services to have those tests performed in house or sent to an outside lab facility by Student Health lab personnel.

Lab tests performed at the Student Health Clinic [CLIA-waived]:

- Flu Rapid Test: a swab inserted into the nostrils that is used to detect the presence of Flu A or Flu B virus in a few minutes.
- Glucose: a venous blood stick, used to check the glucose level in the blood.
- Hemoglobin: a venous blood stick used to check the Hemoglobin level in the body (rule out anemia).
- Mono Test: a venous blood stick is used to diagnosis infectious mononucleosis in a few minutes.
- Pregnancy: tests urine for the presence of major hormone found in pregnant women.
- Strep Screen: a small cotton swab that is grazed across the back of the tonsils and throat is used to test for the presence of Streptococcal bacteria as the likely cause of sore throat.
- Urinalysis: general analysis of urine that is used in diagnosing urinary tract infections and other urine related summaries
- White Blood Count (WBC): a venous blood stick used to check the White Blood Cell count in the body that might indicate presence of an infection.
