



Requirements for Service Animals

If you require the use of a service animal that has been trained to perform tasks for you because of a disability, you are not required to register your service animal, but you may choose to do so. The benefit of registration is that you may be less likely to be questioned about your service animal's presence in Augusta University facilities. However, registration is entirely voluntary.

Service animals must:

1. Be under the control of the handler at all times.
2. Be in compliance with laws pertaining to animal licensing, vaccination and owner identification.

Service animals may be excluded from campus if any of the following occur:

1. The animal is out of control and effective actions is not taken to control it.
2. The animal is not housebroken
3. The animal poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others.

The handler/owner of the service animal will be responsible for any damages or injuries incurred by the service animal.
